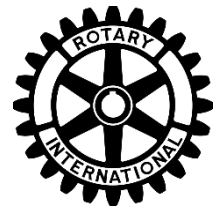

Program: Name: Jenny Goodemote & Staff, Wood Library Update

A brief introduction by Jenny was presented before she introduced several of her staff to report on their individual departments.

Jenny mentioned the library offers a number of ‘kits’ available to patrons that address specific areas of concern such as dementia and wellness. Additionally, the library offers for loan adventure backpacks, fishing poles, WIFI hotspots, and Firestick streaming devices.

Katie Smith, Teen Librarian, spoke about activities undertaken by the Teen Advisory Board and modifications/improvements made to the Teen room area which were largely funded by our Rotary club.

Rachel Brill, Children’s Librarian, outlined a comprehensive list of activities and services offered by her department. These include a “Lego” club, live animal demonstrations, a music program, fire truck displays, and more.

Alexis Lawrence, Adult Program Librarian, spoke about her programs which include quilting and crafts, fitness classes, and cooking classes among others.

Jenny presented statistics on what and how many services were offered last year and wrapped up the presentation with an in-depth budget report delineating the sources of income, the expenses of the library and the future budget proposal that will soon be up for vote.
