As always, the performance was outstanding and included some solos by students in the band.

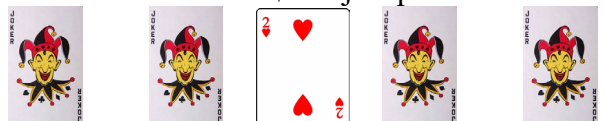
